1. Are you eligible?

The Care Store provides personal hygiene items and household cleaning products that are not eligible for retail purchase through Bridge Cards to anyone in Isabella County that has a referral from one of our partner agencies.

The number of Care Bucks an individual may receive is dependent on the size of their household. Only one individual per address may receive Care Bucks for their household.

Veterans and their family members are especially encouraged to make use of The Care Store.
